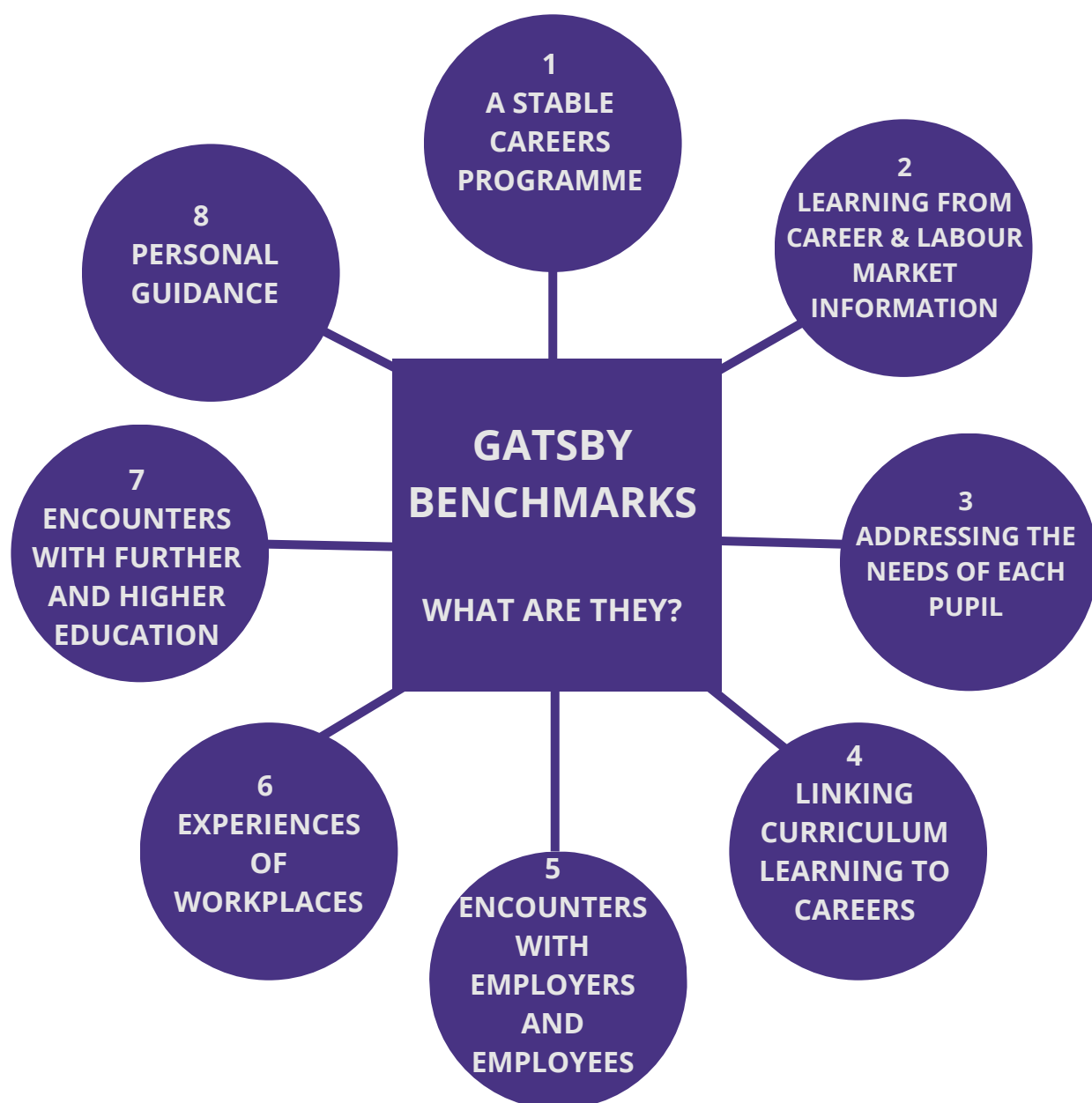

Year 10 & 11

Career Talks

Various employers share their personal career journeys alongside some broader insights into that sector/business.

Mock Interviews

Students will get the opportunity to have a mock interview with an employer from 'the real world'

College Info

unifrog

Unifrog is an online platform that provides students with impartial and independent guidance on the full range of post-school options. The platform is particularly helpful because it is the only place students can compare every undergraduate university course in the UK as well as international opportunities.

Additionally, the Unifrog platform allows students to access FE courses and the most comprehensive list of apprenticeships available across the country, including higher, SLP and degree apprenticeships.

All students in Years 7 – 13 will have access to this website, To log in for the first time, students will be given a sign-up code which is unique to their Form Group.

Work Experience

UCAS Support

Past students experiences since leaving school can help to motivate and inspire our current students to feel more confident in making decisions about their future.

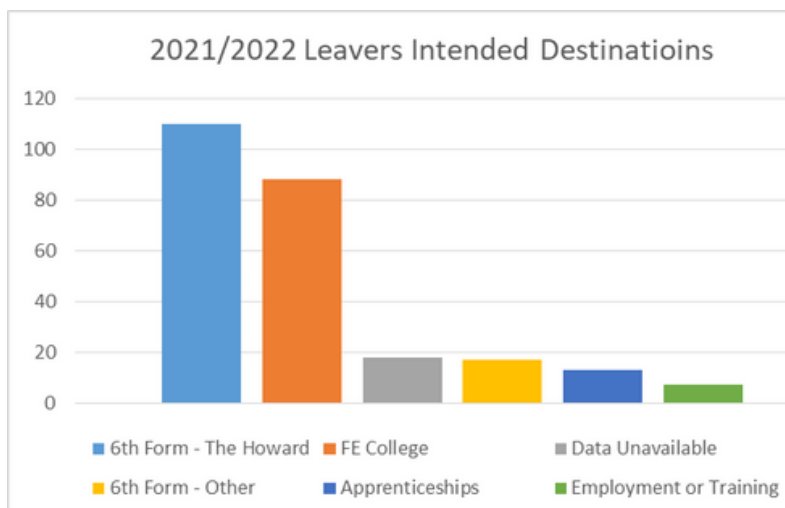
At The Howard School we work with our Alumni to:
